The Peter Principle

The word *disciple*, when translated from Greek, literally means "an apprentice" – someone who wishes to replicate exactly the work and ways of their teacher. When we look at how Jesus trained his disciples/apprentices, he did so in a way that many refer to as "The Peter Principle" (for seemingly obvious reasons). It is a four-step process that goes like this:

- 1. I do, you watch.
- 2. I do, you help.
- 3. You do, I help.
- 4. You do, I watch.

As you see, this process is one of mentored imitation. This directly affects us, as our future as a congregation depends in large part on how we are training the next generation (I am not talking age-wise) to do the jobs we currently hold and do. As things stand right now, often the only time someone steps into a position is when the person formerly holding that position has quit or died. If we continue to do ministry-by-attrition we are failing those who have come before us and those who would have otherwise come after us. We must be intentional in our training of others to do our jobs. Think about all that you do around here: Who have you trained to do those things should you decide to go to Antarctica for a sixmonth vacation? Your church has a void and a problem if there is not someone you can call to do a job you hold. So how do we fix it?

- 1. Look at your job(s) here and find a person who is capable (skill, passion, etc.) of doing that job. Then ask them to help you do that job.
- 2. Patiently teach them what needs done to complete that job.
- 3. Let them do that job with your assistance and partnership.
- 4. Let them do that job their way. Say thank you. Ask them if they know who they were going to train to do that job with them.

With the start of a new school year, it is time for us all to both learn and teach. Be intentional in your service, seeking what's next for you. By doing this you will be teaching your fellow disciples how important it is to find their passion, use their gifts, and train others to do the same.




Beginning October 12, this youth group will happen every 2nd and 4th Sunday from 10:30 AM-noon in the gym at St. Paul's.
